CONSCIOUS II project introduction

The CONSCIOUS II project will provide study materials focusing mainly on practical issues in clinical trials. In addition, several modules will also cover transferable interdisciplinary training, i.e. enhanced skills in leadership, scientific publishing and teaching.

- Who will benefit from the project outputs? The CONSCIOUS II project aims at PhD students and early-career researchers. Moreover, the prepared materials can be used by lecturers.
- What are the project outputs?
 - outlines of each lesson providing an overview of the lesson content; gradually published here: http://conscious2.eu/index.php/results/outlines from May 2022 to March 2023
 - complete, revised lessons suitable for self-study or as a basis for tutor-led classes; gradually published on the training platform (access will be provided via http://conscious2.eu/), provisionally from September 2022
 - pilot lessons free, international, tutor-led online lessons using materials uploaded on the training platform
 dates to be specified, tentatively from November 2023 to April 2024
 - recordings of the pilot lessons as an additional form of learning material or as a manual for trainers on how to use all the project materials.
- Who are the project partners? Masaryk University, together with the University of Pécs, the University of Szeged, the
 University College of Cork, NOVA University Lisbon and Université Paris Cité, cooperate to develop high quality study
 materials and to open international online courses.
 - ECRIN is an associate partner, reviewer of all materials in this project and all participating organizations are members of the ECRIN-ERIC network.
